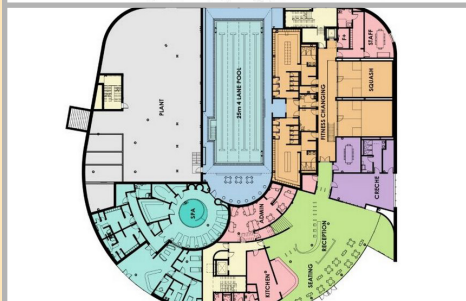

## NEW DESTINATION AND WATER FACILITY

Following a detailed review of existing city wide leisure facilities, a decision was taken by Coventry City Council to invest in a new City Centre Destination Leisure facility.

The new 7,000m<sup>2</sup> facility is due to commence on site in early 2017 and following a two year design process will deliver some of the most modern and iconic facilities within an indoor leisure facility in the United Kingdom.

Constructed on a City Centre site adjacent to a listed spire, the new facility will provide:

- A high level waterpark providing new high octane rides and kids play area
- Wave pool and lazy river located within the waterpark
- 25m, 4-lane pool
- Fitness suites, spin studio and dance studio
- Spa and health club
- Crèche
- Associated changing
- Cafe area

The design process has involved the procurement and knowledge of some of the leading providers of water facilities within the United Kingdom and the design is a combination of best practice and innovation following a number of benchmarking visits across Europe.
