### ARC LEISURE CENTRE

The design team brief for this project was to provide 'an innovative and exciting new sport, leisure and tourist attraction for the Peak District'.

The site proposed for the project provided for one of the most interesting and challenging projects the team were involved in. A sloping site and a former landfill tip, the site was remediated and building carefully positioned to minimise slope stability issues.

The completed facility provided:

- 8-lane main swimming pool with full moveable floor
- learner pool incorporating 'beach' and leisure fun features
- 8 court sports hall
- gymnasium, studios and multi-purpose spaces
- changing facilities (wet and dry)
- cafe/kitchen area
- external facilities including MUGA activities and BMX trails, etc
